TEACHER EVALUATIONS



47% of teachers reported that there were changes to their performance evaluation in the 2020/2021 school year.

A large majority of those teachers, 83%, had very little or no input to those changes.



ONLINE INSTRUCTION



For teachers who felt unprepared to teach online, only 34% thought teacher evaluations were fair and accurate.

81% of teachers either had no training for online teaching, or believed their training was inadequate.



GENERAL HEALTH DURING THE PANDEMIC



61% of educators are only somewhat secure with the health and safety precautions taken by their district

29% are considering leaving the profession, permanently or temporarily, due to COVID-19.
